Dearest Parents,

Alhamdulillah, we are already three weeks into Term 2!

Weather experts predict a drier and warmer-than-usual winter; however, they also highlight that it may still be unpredictable. This is important for us, as well as for parents, as it allows us to better plan day-to-day activities and events that will enrich our little ones' learning in a safe and secure manner.



Please remember that the winter months often bring more viruses and infections. Kindly ensure your child is supported with healthy, immune-boosting foods. We also request that parents keep their little ones at home if they have green or yellow nasal discharge, as this is often the first indication of an infection.

The majority of our learners are on the normal developmental curve, Alhamdulillah. At our recent staff meeting, teachers highlighted that a number of learners are showing challenges with attention. Signs of difficulty with attention may include:

- Inability to sit still during circle time
- Constant movement, fidgeting, or wandering
- Calling out answers and not taking turns
- Difficulty following two-step instructions
- Emotional outbursts (crying or shouting)



This is a global concern and may be linked to one or more of the following:

- Underdeveloped self-regulation (i.e., children's executive brain functions are still developing — focus, control, and memory)
- Overstimulation (e.g., excessive screen time)
- Poor sleep routines
- Lack of structured play
- Emotional insecurities

The table below provides a guide to typical behaviours versus possible red flags:

Typical Behaviour	Red Flags
Short attention span (3-10 minutes, depending on age)	Cannot focus even for 1-2 minutes
Occasional tantrums	Extreme aggression or constant disruption
High energy	No response to routine or structure
—	Difficulty engaging in any activity

We will inform parents if your child falls outside the expected behavioural range.
